Our Promise to Kaitiaki

In the spirit of partnership, protection and co-operation, Ngā Taonga acknowledges Kaitiaki rights to speak for their Taonga Māori. Our relationships with Kaitiaki are based on the following principles:

Mana Taonga

Taonga Māori possess mana and mauri. Kaitiakitanga fosters the retention of mātauranga Māori and ancestral connections.

We provide opportunities for Kaitiaki whānau, hapū and iwi to reconnect with their taonga, and contribute descriptions in our catalogue.

Mana Tūturu

Mana tūturu is the perpetual spiritual and cultural guardianship exercised by Kaitiaki over their taonga.

Guardianship and cultural property rights co-exist, augmenting legally protected relationships with Taonga Māori.

Manaakitanga

Respect, generosity and care underpin our relationships with Kaitiaki and discussions about appropriate access and reuse of their taonga.

We seek clearance from Kaitiaki to ensure that access requests do not compromise the mana of their taonga.

He Pātaka Tūturu

Ngā Taonga provides a secure, climate-controlled storehouse for the physical care, protection and preservation of Taonga Māori.

We work with Kaitiaki to provide archival and technical expertise in the care of audiovisual taonga.



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
