Responsibility for obtaining the permission of the copyright holder to publish, before publication, is the responsibility of the applicant. Where possible Ngā Taonga Sound & Vision documentation staff may assist in obtaining the copyright holder's permission.
2. Permission to reproduce material does not grant exclusive rights of any kind or imply transfer of copyright to the user.
3. The user will acknowledge Ngā Taonga Sound & Vision as the holder of the original material as stated in the acknowledgement at the bottom of the page.
